BYLAW No. 163-2010

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW No. 151-2005 – THE NUISANCE BYLAW

The council of the Town of Cut Knife, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. Bylaw No. 151-2005 is amended as hereinafter set forth:
- 2. Add new section 29(a):

Materials removed from a property as a result of a Nuisance Order shall be stored at a place designated by the Council of the Town of Cut Knife for a period of thirty (30) days. At the end of the thirty (30) day period if these materials have not been picked up by the owner, they will be held for a further thirty (30) days. Storage charges of a minimum of \$10.00 per day and a maximum of \$20.00 per day will be charged. The materials may be picked up at any time during normal office hours. If the materials are picked up during the second thirty (30) day period, the owner will be charged storage for that portion of the period the materials were held by the Town of Cut Knife. The daily charges will be set by Council dependant on the size, etc of the articles removed. At the end of the second thirty (30) day period, the Council of the Town of Cut Knife will offer for public sale the remaining articles. The funds realized from this sale will be applied first to the cost of the initial removal of the articles; remaining funds will be applied to the storage charges. If there are funds remaining after these charges have been applied, the remainder of the funds will be paid to the owner, if known. If the owner is not known, the funds will be retained by the Town and placed in General Revenue.
