This has resulted in conversations on how to finance this project. Once the well is been installed, a temporary water restriction may be in place to complete the rest of the project. Our maintenance staff have done a great job on tree trimming to help with site lines near intersections. SaskPower has also been busy this past summer trimming trees along all power lines to help prevent any loss of power or damage.
