## TOWN OF CUT KNIFE BYLAW # 4-2018

## A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CUT KNIFE TO CLASSIFY, REGULATE, CONTROL, AND LICENCE ANY BUSINESS, TRADE OR CALLING WITHIN THE TOWN OF CUT KNIFE EXCEPT THOSE BUSINESSESS.

The council of the Town of Cut Knife, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

This Bylaw shall be citied as "Business Licencing Bylaw" enacts as follows.

## 2. **DEFINITIONS**

- a) In this Bylaw "Municipality" means the Town of Cut Knife.
- b) "Administrator" means the Administrator of the Town of Cut Knife.
- c) "Business" means any of the following activities, whether or not for profit and however organized or formed.
  - i) a commercial, merchandising, or industrial activity or undertaking;
  - ii) the carrying on of a profession, trade, occupation, calling or employment;
  - iii) an activity providing goods or services;
- d) "Bylaw enforcement Officer" means the individual or designate who is authorized by the Town to enforce this bylaw.
- e) "Contractor" means a person who constructs, alters, maintains, repairs of removes buildings or structures, Professional Arborists and landscapers. Installs heating plants, plumbing or other fixtures or performs other similar work in the Town and who does not have a commercial premise in the Town.
- f) "Direct Seller" means a person who goes from house to house selling or offering for sale, or soliciting orders for the future delivery of goods and services.
- g) "Licensee" means the holder of a business licence issued pursuant to this bylaw.
- h) "Petty Trades" means every person carrying on a business as a knife grinder, saw sharpener, skate sharpener, sewing alterations, locksmith or similar occupations.
- i) "Transient Trader" means every person carrying on businesses as a transient trader as defined by The Municipalities Act.
- j) "Town" means the Town of Cut Knife.
- Welder" means every person carrying on the business of electrical welding, fusion welding, oxaceteylene welding or cold welding.
- 3. No person shall carry on any trade, business or calling within the Town unless they have in their possession a valid existing licence for the purposes issued in accordance with the provisions of this Bylaw.
- 4. Any person required to obtain a licence under this bylaw shall make application to the Administrator.
- 6. Each application shall be in the form as set out on "Exhibit A" attached to this Bylaw and applicable licence fee shall be paid in full at the time of filing the application.
- 7. The fee payable for a licence under this bylaw shall be \$150.00. Licence fees shall become due and a business licence shall be applied for on January 1 of each year or any time during the year upon a person engaging in a business, industry, calling or occupation which requires a licence pursuant to this bylaw.
- 8. Every licence issued pursuant to this Bylaw shall expire on December 31 unless sooner suspended or revoked.
- 9. Each application for a licence shall include the following information:
  - a) The name and address of both the applicant and the business
  - b) The specific nature of the business for which the licence is required.
  - c) The place where the business in respect of which the licence is required is to be exercised or carried on.

- 10. The administrator shall issue a receipt to the applicant for the licence fee tendered with the application in Section 9 with such receipt donating approval of application.
- 11. The Council may refuse, suspend or revoke a licence in its absolute discretion, but it shall give reasons for any refusal, suspension or revocation and its actions are not open to review by any court. Licences that are suspended or revoked until a licensee has been given full opportunity to heard by the Council.
- 12. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offense and liable, on summary conviction, to a fine of \$ 250.00
- 13. Bylaw number 29-1993, is hereby repealed.
- 14. The Bylaw shall take effect January 1, 2019.
