

A BYLAW RESPECTING FIREWORKS

The Council of the Town of Cut Knife, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:

"council" means the council of the Town of Cut Knife;

"fireworks" means firecrackers, rockets, squibs or any other object or substance designed to be exploded or burned to produce noises or brilliant lighting effects and does not include: paper percussion caps for toy guns; firecrackers less than 3 inches in length; sparklers; flares used as emergency warning markers on highways or railways;

"town" means the Town of Cut Knife.

2. Subject to sections 3 and 4 hereof no person shall sell fireworks in the town.
3. The council may authorize a designated officer of the town to issue to any person or corporation a written permit authorizing the sale in the town of fireworks or any class thereof as may be specified in the permit, the duration of which permit may be specified thereon.
4. No person or corporation shall sell fireworks to any person who has not attained the full age of 18 years and it shall be the responsibility of a vendor of fireworks to ensure that a purchaser has attained this age.
5. Subject to section 6 hereof, no person shall set off, detonate, ignite or cause to be exploded any fireworks in the town.
6. (a) The council may authorize a designated officer of the town to issue to any person or persons who have attained the full age of 18 years a written permit authorizing the setting off in the town or in any part or parts of the town, as may be specified in the permit, of fireworks or any class or classes thereof, as may be specified in the permit, the duration of which permit may be specified therein.
- (b) A permit issued under clause (a) of this section shall prescribe the conditions under which a display of fireworks or any specified class or classes thereof may be held in the town or in any specified part or parts of the town and no persons shall conduct a display of fireworks in contravention of such prescribed conditions.
7. A person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and, upon summary conviction, shall be liable to the penalties provided for in the general penalty bylaw of the town.
