Hello Everyone,

The Community Showcase Event that was hosted on February 7<sup>th</sup> was a great success. The Town Council are planning to discuss the possibility of hosting the event again next year so please stay tuned for that.

Thank you to everyone who volunteered their time and showed their support at the Civic Centre this past hockey season. A big thank you to Cut Knife Innovation Federal Credit Union for once again sponsoring the Public Skating ice slot as well as approving the Legacy Development Grant for the Cut Knife Recreation Board in the amount of \$25,000.<sup>00</sup> for upgrades to the Ice Refrigeration Plant. The Civic Centre is now closed for the season and will re-open in November.

The Town of Cut Knife will once again be celebrating Canada Day on Wednesday, July 1<sup>st</sup>. This year's committee will have lots of activities planned, including another firework display to cap off the festivities. With winter still ongoing, please remember that all property owners adjacent to a side walk are required to remove any snow, ice or other loose debris within twenty-four (24) hours of the time it was formed or it will then be completed by the Town and any expenses are to be sent to said property owner as per Snow Removal Bylaw 192-2025.

Once we finally reach the spring season and the weather is beginning to warm up which means it is time for spring cleaning and yard maintenance. Please be sure to remove any garbage or debris that may have accumulated on your property during this past winter. This includes any pet or animal waste.

Which is a reminder that all pet dogs and cats are required to be on a leash wearing a tag. These pet tags must be registered and purchased at the Town Office for \$25.<sup>00</sup> with any replacement tags costing \$10.<sup>00</sup>. The Town also asks any pet owners to be mindful of the noise towards your neighbours.

If there are any property owners in Cut Knife that are looking to rent out their house to a tenant, please let the Town Office know. They receive phone calls about people looking for rental properties in town and if they know of any properties that are available for rent the staff can pass the message along.

If you have any extra business cards you can drop some off at the Town Office for our new display holders.

The Town is also looking at updating the zoning map and some other items within the Zoning Bylaw. A separate Public Hearing Notice for April 20, 2026 at 20:00 is to follow. Please watch our website for updates.
